2020/2021 UNIVERSITY OF MALAWI SELECTION OF ECONOMIC FEE PAYING, MATURE ENTRY, BRIDGING COURSE AND, OPEN DISTANCE AND E-LEARNING PROGRAMME STUDENTS

The University of Malawi (UNIMA) Council on 23rd December, 2020 approved the names of candidates who have been admitted into the University to pursue various programmes for the 2020/2021 academic year under the following categories: Economic Fee Paying, Mature Entry, Bridging Course and, Open Distance and E-Learning. All candidates have been selected on non-residential basis.

An offer letter will be issued to each selected candidate where the candidate is expected to indicate their acceptance. Candidates who are not ready to take up their places, should inform their respective Colleges in writing within 21 days from the date Council released the results. Candidates who wish to reserve their place should accordingly do so in writing to their College's Registrar before the academic year begins. Reservations of a place lasts only for one year.

ECONOMIC FEE-PAYING STUDENTS

There are 29 candidates selected into various programmes in UNIMA comprising 20 males and 9 females.

MATURE ENTRY PROGRAMMES

There are 118 candidates selected into various programmes in UNIMA comprising 50 males and 68 females.
