

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN HIV MEDICINE

HIV continues to be a major health issue in Malawi. Malawi aims to control the HIV epidemic by the year 2030. To achieve this, trained health care workers are needed. Kamuzu University of Health Sciences (KUHeS) is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates to undergo training in Postgraduate Diploma in HIV Medicine. The PG diploma is a one and half-year parttime course which will train clinicians into Specialist HIV Care Providers to provide HIV care at advanced level at central hospitals, district hospitals and health centres.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

KUHeS has The U.S. President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) funding through Centre for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to support training of 20 students which will be awarded competitively following an interview process. The bursaries will cover tuition fees, stipend and accessories to allow for E-learning.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Minimum of a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing, Bachelor of Science in a clinical field (Paediatrics and Child Health, Internal Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Anaesthesia and ICU) or a medical degree (MBBS). Additionally, the students should be registered by the medical or nursing councils of Malawi
